



QUICK START GUIDE

National Geographic's Online Practice LMS Integration is designed to help you seamlessly integrate our digital resources within your institution's D2L-BrightSpace Learning Management System. This is a simple process that you should be able to complete using the steps outlined in this document. This Quick Start guide provides basic steps for setting up your LMS environment.

CREATE A NEW COURSE TEMPLATE

1. Go to the Course Management section of D2L and select **Create a new course template and a new course offering that has never been offered before**
2. Use a name that will make it easy to identify. We suggest NGL, the book and level.
Ex: NGL World Link Level 1
3. We recommend you create a course template for each NGL product you have adopted
4. Once you have created the course you will need to configure an LTI tool with the parameters sent to you in our configuration document.

CONFIGURE THE LTI TOOL

1. Navigate to the course you created.

2. Select Course Admin and click on External Learning Tools.

3. Click on New Link to add the NGL LTI tool.
 - a. Title should match the name and level of the NGL product.
 - b. URL should be the Launch URL from the configuration document.
 - i. <https://learn.eltngl.com/lti/v1/launch>
 - c. Add the Key and Secret provided in the configuration document.
 - i. Key: 889ea673e5730ddjs72773cd849ffc318b9 (example)
 - ii. Secret: x2v52d37ce4dc0ea136262e707a137b5ea7ac5ac (example)
 - d. Add one custom parameter for the book and level associated with the course.
 - i. Name: custom_isbn
 - ii. Value: 9780357784631 (ISBN provided in the configuration document)
 - e. Use Link Security Settings – click all that apply.
4. Click Save and Close.

5. Repeat the above procedure for each Course & ISBN.

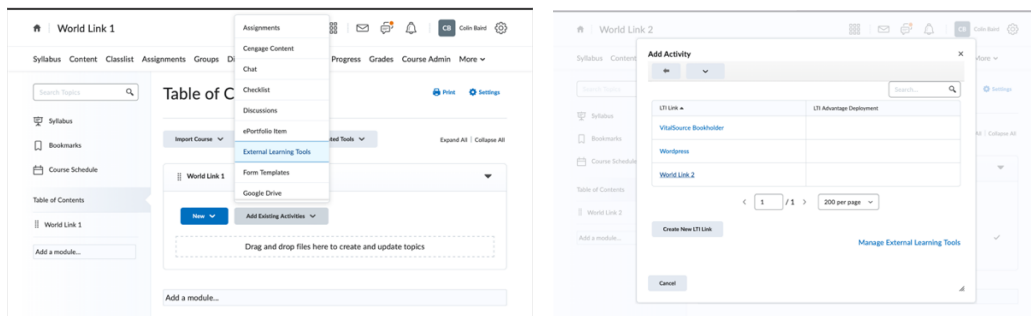

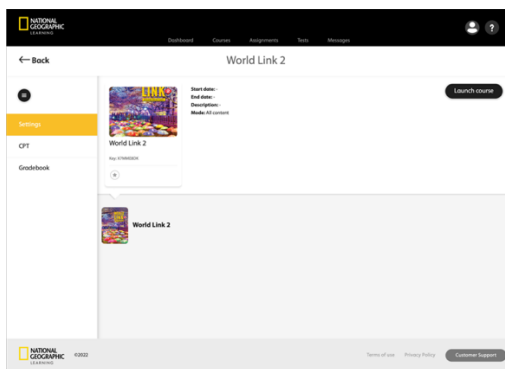
